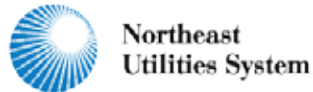

EXCITE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ABOUT ENERGY

- High school students are introduced to energy, how it works, how it is generated, and how it is delivered.
- Students are informed about the career options available in the energy industry that could align with their personal preferences and skills.

EXPLORE ENERGY CAREER PATHS

- Representatives from local energy utilities present at local schools to increase the students' awareness of the specific jobs and career paths available.
- Local energy employers host the students at their various locations to expose them to job options, provide a hands-on experience with utility equipment, and show them a 'day in the life' of an energy worker.



ENERGY EDUCATION - ONLINE

- The online course, *Mathematics of Electricity - Careers in Electric Power*, combines career awareness and math concepts applied in real-world energy industry assignments. This high school credit course has been jointly developed by the Virtual High School and industry representatives from EPCE and is aligned with ITEA and national mathematics standards.
- Students are encouraged to continue their energy education through a local community college or the energy specific online Associate's and Bachelor's degree options through BSC and EPCE.



EMPLOY LOCALLY IN ENERGY

- One-on-one advising, resume and interview assistance, and industry entry exam test prep courses help students move into the industry workforce.
- The partnership with the utility employer opens the door for students to local jobs that allow them to remain in their home community while providing the industry a workforce where it's needed.
